¹ As stated in the Inter-cantonal Agreement on Universities of Applied Sciences and Arts, the citizens that are considered as "Swiss and foreign residents" are those that either have a Swiss passport, or those who are foreign nationals over the age of majority who have resided in Switzerland without interruption for at least two years while simultaneously being in gainful employment that has enabled them to be financially independent, as well as those whose legal guardians are domiciled in a Swiss canton.

² During the Bachelor of Arts programmes, final exams start taking place already at the end of the 1st year of study. That is why the final exams fee must be paid on the 2nd semester of the first year, and not on the second half of the 3rd year of studies.
