Guide

It is the student's responsibility to organise their own chamber music ensemble(s), register them with the Heads of Performance, and organise the lessons with the Professors. For further information, please read the Chamber Music guide on the Conservatorio's website.

Registering a chamber music ensemble

Chamber music groups are to be registered using this form, which must be completed in full. The form must be handed in to the course leaders or to the didactic secretariat.

Lesson hours

The forms must be submitted to the Heads of Performance who allocate the lesson hours, normally between 8 and 12 hours depending on the difficulty of the piece. Only in exceptional cases may extra hours be allocated.

Lessons

Once approval has been obtained from the Heads of Performance, the student in charge of the ensemble coordinates rehearsals and lessons with the Professor(s).

Obtaining credits

A prerequisite for the awarding of credits is—in addition to individual study, ensemble rehearsals and participation in lessons—the complete performance of the piece. The seminar lecturers or the Professors responsible for the ensembles coordinate the specific assessment procedures with the Heads of Performance.
